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Summary

Dr. Federica Paolucci, Ph.D., is a Postdoctoral Researcher in Constitutional Law and Fundamental Rights at [Bocconi University](#). Her research investigates the regulation of artificial intelligence and the protection of fundamental rights, with a focus on biometric technologies, Fundamental Rights Impact Assessments, procedural safeguards, and European digital regulation. She is currently involved in the FIS DIGCON project, where she contributes to the development and testing of legal and methodological tools for assessing the impact of AI systems on fundamental rights.

Long biography

Dr. Federica Paolucci, Ph.D., is a Post-Doctoral Researcher in Constitutional Law and Fundamental Rights at [Bocconi University](#). Her research focuses on artificial intelligence regulation, fundamental rights, biometric technologies, and impact assessments in European and international legal frameworks. She holds a PhD in Legal Studies from Bocconi University, awarded *cum laude*, with a dissertation entitled *Constitutional Safeguards in the Age of AI. A Study on the Fundamental Rights Impact Assessment of Facial Recognition Technology*. Her doctoral research is being developed into a forthcoming monograph with Routledge, in the Digital Law and Governance series.

Her work investigates how constitutional law can contribute to the governance of artificial intelligence systems by designing legal, procedural, and institutional safeguards for the protection of fundamental rights. She is particularly interested in the AI Act, biometric identification systems, facial recognition technologies, Fundamental Rights Impact Assessments, proportionality, accountability, and the allocation of responsibilities among public and private actors involved in AI governance.

Federica is currently a Postdoctoral Research Fellow within the FIS DIGCON project on rights, remedies, and policy in the algorithmic society. Within this project, her research contributes to the development of a methodological framework for assessing the fundamental rights implications of AI systems and related governance processes. Her work includes the design of assessment tools, templates, and indicators, as well as the testing of these instruments in controlled and reversible settings. This research aims to produce evidence-based knowledge on how impact assessments, compliance mechanisms, and governance models can effectively protect fundamental rights beyond formal or purely procedural compliance.

As part of her current research activity, Federica is also involved in the coordination and supervision of research work connected to the project, including the supervision of two research assistants and thesis students working on topics related to AI regulation, fundamental rights, and digital governance.

Alongside her research, Federica teaches digital law at Bocconi University. She is the Program Coordinator of the [LL.M. in Law of Technology and Automated Systems](#) and the Academic Coordinator of the "Rights in Action" Legal Clinic. Her academic work includes peer-reviewed publications, edited volumes, policy papers, conference presentations, invited talks, and participation in European and international scholarly networks. She is a member of [OCEAN](#), the Open Council of Europe Academic Network, and ICON-S, the International Society of Public Law.

Her publications address the constitutional implications of AI regulation, the protection of fundamental rights in the digital society, biometric technologies, facial recognition, the AI Act, and the role of impact assessments in rights-based governance. She has contributed to

academic and policy debates on AI regulation through journal articles, book chapters, policy papers, blog posts, and invited interventions in national and international conferences.
